Health protocols:

IUSD's Health Department has created IUSD's Health
Guidelines for COVID-19. These guidelines provide detailed information on healthy hygiene practices, school and district preparations for student illness and injury, return to school practices, overall maintenance of a healthy environment, and accommodating special considerations. These practices are being implemented here at Deerfield and our staff is being trained based on these guidelines. In addition, there is a Daily Screening Tool available and a "Know the Symptoms" graphic for parents to use each day as they assess their child's health prior to sending him or her to school. Please review these documents for a comprehensive understanding of these practices and expectations.

Custodial practices

IUSD's Maintenance and Operations Department has created enhanced cleaning protocols for our schools sites based on recommendations from our local health agencies. These enhancements include augmentations to our HVAC systems, increased filtration and providing individual air purification units in each classroom. In addition, for custodial services at the local site level, enhanced practices have been developed around cleaning/disinfecting protocols, daily service to the facility, focusing on frequently touched surfaces and specific responses to any known or suspected COVID-10 cases.
